# SML Barn Quilts to Quilts

### Process

- Take a drive and find a barn quilt (on a barn, boat house, chicken coop, fence, any structure) in Bedford, Franklin or Pittsylvania Counties
- Take a picture of the structure with the barn quilt on it
- Make a notation of the address of the barn quilt (A list of location is available at guild meetings. The challenge is not limited to this list. If you find one in any of the three counties, it is eligible for the challenge.)

### Challenge Rules:

- Create a quilt, wall hanging, article of clothing or any other item (has to be quilted -three layers with stitching to hold together). No size restrictions
- The colors of the block in your quilt have to be the same colors as the barn quilt you took the picture of.
- The same barn quilt can be used by more than one guild member (That will be where creativity comes in, and shades of the colors in the barn quilt)
- All entries must be complete (binding, buttons, etc. whatever is needed to be finished). Incomplete entries will be shown in a "display only" area and not considered for judging.

### Submitting Entries:

- Complete the entry form (Available at Guild Meetings from any member of the River Queen Bee)
- You must submit the photograph of the barn quilt and the address of its location with your entry
- The block in the photograph must be identified on your entry form (Ohio Star, Log Cabin, etc.)
- Entries are due at the December holiday celebration
