

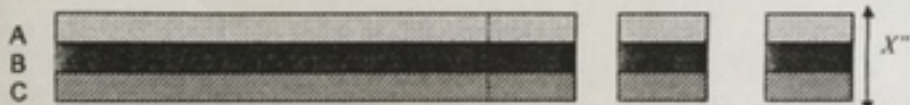
## Rail Fence Quilt

This kit includes 6 strips each of fabrics A, B and C, 5 strips for border and 1 piece of backing fabric.

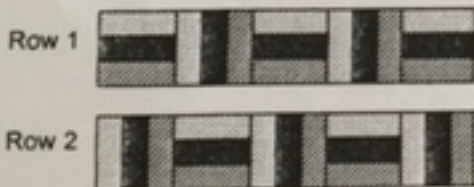
\*Fabric requirements:  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. fabric A  $\frac{3}{4}$  yd border fabric  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. fabric B  $1\frac{1}{2}$  yds. of backing fabric  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. fabric C  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd. backing

\*Cutting instructions: From fabric A cut six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips  
 From fabric B cut six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips  
 From fabric C cut six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips  
 From border fabric, cut five ~~3~~  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " STRIPS

Using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout, sew fabric strips A to fabric strips B and then to fabric strips C. Press seams. Measure the width of the sewn strip ( $X''$ ) and cut sections that are exactly same dimension. (This will be about  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".)

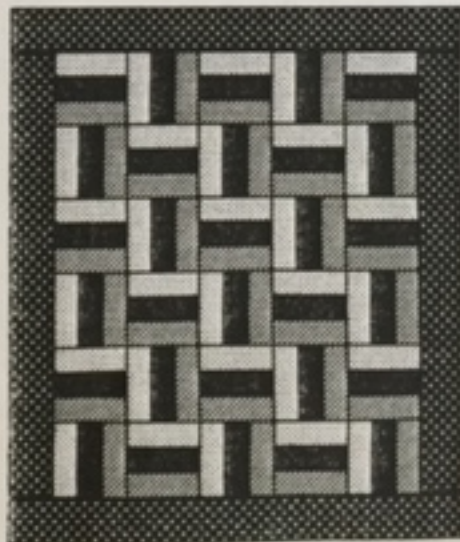


Cut thirty of these squares. Sew into rows of five squares with the fabric arranged in the diagrams of rows 1 and 2. You will have three rows of each arrangement.



Sew rows together alternating Row 1 and Row 2 to form the center of the quilt. Sew the border strips to the longer sides of the rectangle piecing two strips together if necessary. Then sew the shorter sides.

Finished quilt is about  $42'' \times 48''$   
 ~~$38'' \times 42''$~~
