“JELLY ROLL RACE”

Make a quilt top with ONE jelly roll only. No other fabrics are needed to make the 50” x 64” quilt top. Just a quick, fun way to make progress in a day. Most participants will leave with a finished top. **This is NOT a race but there WILL BE PRIZES!** Lots of fun for everyone and a **GRAND** prize winner.

Whether you race or not, you will learn how to turn a jelly roll (40 strips cut 2 1/2” x 42 inches) into a gracious sized throw. If you can sew a straight seam, you can do this!

JELLY ROLL RACE SUPPLY LIST

Choose a jelly roll in the fabrics of your choice for a fast quilt top for a day of stress free sewing. True jelly rolls contain 40 strips that are cut 2 1/2” inches. **(Pre-purchase your own jelly roll or buy one from Cathy the day of the workshop. Check out her inventory at: www.StitchPartyStudio.com.)**



We will start with the jelly roll as it was purchased. Instructions will be given for joining the strips on the day of the race.

Please bring the following to the workshop:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- 4 pre-wound bobbins in a neutral color thread
- Jelly Roll
- Pair of sharp fabric scissors
- A few straight pins
- And a smile! 😊
